### Product Content Policy

The Las Vegas Greek Food Festival is the largest non-profit cultural event in Clark County, hosted by St. John the Baptist Greek Orthodox Church. Vendor inventory must reflect the values of a faith-based, family-friendly environment.

### **Prohibited Items (Effective 2025):**

- **Profane, vulgar, suggestive, or blatantly controversial content** on clothing or merchandise (in English, Greek, or any language)
- Evil eye jewelry (mati, nazar, blue eye, eye of protection)
- Any imagery or items that mock or disrespect Christian or Greek Orthodox religious symbols

**Vendors found offering these items will be asked not to display or sell them during the festival.**
